I started my PGA in 2011 with Alf Hopf at the UKZN Driving Range and since then I have grown to work in different fields of the golf industry. I moved to Scottburgh to co/own a Pro Shop and worked part time with Cobra Puma Golf as a Rep. I then moved to work with Don Gammon at Durban Country Club where I did coaching and then was given the opportunity to move into a Golf Operations roll at DCC.

I joined Princes Grant in August 2017 as the Golf Manger. Where I filled the roll to the best of my ability by introducing demo days and running promotions for the Members! At this time the Pro shop was just ticking along and covering its costs. With my relationships with the local reps I was able to get old accounts back that had fallen away and introduced new stock to the shop growing the yearly turn over by 30%. I was part of the Committee that implemented the changes to the course and the resurfacing of the front 9 putting greens that has made a huge change to the playability of the course opening it up to all levels of golfer. The changers were done at the beginning of 2019 and we reopened the course in June 2019 where the feedback from all who have played it has been incredible. I did a lot of work with the Junior Golfers coaching Kyle Kistensamy to achieve his goal of making the KZN u/19 team in 2018. In 2019 he won both the Umhlali and Princes Grant Club Championships in the same year.

My role here at Prince's Grant have changed over the year, where I stepped in as Acting Lodge Manager between Princes Grant being able to find a replacement for the position.

In February I was appointed as the Club Manger and would take on the role of overseeing The Lodge as well as the golf.

Since my appointment I have hosted some very successful events with live music over weekends and introducing specials in the bar getting members back to enjoy the dinners and Club Life again.

In between all the work I have also been able to achieve the following as a player and competing in Local and National events.

I have won the KZN Order of Merit for the last 4 years and in that time I have won some of our bigger reginal events such as the Funder raiser plate event in 2017 and 2018. The Reginal Championship in 2018 and in the same season I was selected to be part of the South African PGA Team to compete in the International Teams Championship in Greece at the end of 2018. I finished the 2018 season placed 2nd on the National Order of Merit.
